







Benefits and risks of Al

Table 3. Author's guide before writing and submitting an AI-assisted manuscript

Journals generally ask you to declare/indicate

- · Which AI model was used, when and by whom?
- · The rationale for the use of AI and how it is used
- · All prompts and responses
- · Where in your article the AI-generated content appears?

During the manuscript writing process

- · Check the accuracy of all references
- · Ensure that all concepts are properly attributed
- · Ensure that the language used is neutral and inclusive
- · Check the similarity of text for plagiarism
- · Read the journal and/or publisher's AI policy carefully

AI = artificial intelligence.
