

What is Open Science?


- To increase the scientific and societal impact of science
- It involves all scientific disciplines and aspects of scholarly practices






What is Open Science?

- Make scientific knowledge openly available, accessible and reusable
- Increase scientific collaborations for the benefit of science and society
- Open the process of knowledge creation, evaluation and communication to societal actors beyond the traditional scientific community

- Transparency, visibility and trust





